WELCOME....

Welcome to the 19th Annual Lilydale Invitational Charolais sale.

As I write this welcome, it is pleasing to see the EYCI at 993 c/kg and late seasonal rain putting a green pick in the paddocks before winter sets in. Demand for Charolais and Charolais-infused cattle continues to dominate saleyard prices across Queensland, and weight for age is still king. At the Beaudesert Euro Sale earlier in the year and the recent Toogoolawah Weaner Sale, pen after pen of quality Charolais and Charolais-infused weaners with length, width and depth were a sight to behold and highly sought after.

Our sale group will present 35 Charolais bulls, of which 26 are polled, along with two females. All bulls have been semen tested and scanned for eye muscle area, rib and rump fat, blooded for tick fever and three-day sickness, and have received either their 7-in-1 or 5-in-1 vaccinations.

If you intend to purchase at the sale, we recommend having a couple of cows or steers waiting in the yards at home. This helps any new arrivals calm down and settle into their new surroundings.

This year, we are again offering free transport to Beaudesert via Moreton Saleyards and to Coolabunia (T & C apply). Supplementary sheets will be available on sale day or on request prior to the sale. Inspections can be arranged through our sale agent, Boyd O'Brien & Bartholomew. The agents can also assist if transport is required for any purchases, and transport operators will be in attendance on sale day.

Online bidding is available through STOCKLIVE if you are unable to attend.

Insurance representatives will be in attendance, and purchases can be insured sale day.

Safety: Please remember these bulls will be in an unfamiliar environment come sale day. Do not enter the bull pens. If you need to stand one up for assessment, please ask the vendor, they will be happy to assist.

We extend an invitation to everyone to join the vendors for after sale refreshments. A canteen will be operating on sale day.

SALE INFORMATION....

INSPECTION: All animals will be available for inspection at the Toogoolawah Showgrounds Wednesday 23rd July. Prior inspections are welcome anytime by contacting the individual vendor.

TRANSPORT: Free transport is being offer to Beaudesert saleyards via Moreton saleyards and to Coolabunia (T&C apply).

TICK TREATMENT: All animals will be pre-treated and ready to clear to tick free areas.

OUTSIDE AGENT REBATE: 3% is offered to outside agents who attend the sale with, or buy on behalf of, their clients and settle within 7 days. 1% rebate to any outside agents introducing approved buyers to the Sale Committee prior to the sale and settling on their behalf within 7 days of the sale.

CANTEEN: A canteen will be operation on sale day.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION:

All bulls will be:

- scanned for eye muscle area, rib and rump fat and marbling (IMF)

- semen tested prior to the sale and weighed.

All females will either be preg tested in calf or unjoined.

This information will be available on the supplementary sheet prior to the sale.

ONLINE BIDDING: Online bidding will be conducted through Stocklive Elite. Please see previous page for instructions on how to register and bid. We recommend registering at least 24 hours prior to the sale.

INSURANCE: Ownership is transferred at point of sale. Nutrien Livestock can be concted by phone on sale day to arrange insurance.

SALE INFORMATION Cont....

WARRANTY:

THE VENDOR WARRANTS THAT: Bulls are fertile and capable of natural service within 6 months of date of sale to the purchaser (Warranty Period) and

THE VENDOR WILL EITHER: Provide a satisfactory replacement or provide a credit for use at the next Lilydale Charolais Invitational Sale equal to the purchase price (excluding any costs and expenses of the purchaser in taking delivery) minus salvage value.

WHERE:

The purchaser claims a bull is infertile, upon purchaser submitting a veterinary report after the expiration of the Warranty Period stating that the bull is infertile or incapable of natural service, and a Statutory Declaration by the purchaser to the effect that the substance of the report is true and correct. The veterinarian must state that in his/ her opinion there is no evidence that the bull has suffered any injury or illness during the Warranty Period which could have affected his breeding ability. The veterinary report and Statutory Declaration must be forwarded to the seller within 14 days of the Warranty Period expiring.

THE PURCHASER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT: The purchaser does not rely and it is unreasonable for the purchaser to rely on the skill or judgement of the seller as to whether the bulls supplied are reasonably fit for any purpose for which they are being acquired.

To the extent permitted by law all other conditions and warranties implied by law in respect of the state, quality and condition of the bulls which may apart from this clause be binding on the Seller are excluded. The Seller has no liability (including liability in negligence) to any person for any loss or damage consequential or otherwise suffered or incurred by that person arising from the sale of the bulls to the purchaser.

TAKING YOUR NEW BULL HOME: On arrival at their new home it is important that a suitable mob of animals is on hand to greet the bull to minimise the stress on the bull. Suitable animals include pregnant cows or steers, **not** other bulls.

Bovine Progressive Ataxia (BPA) is an incoordination observed starting in the rear legs of young adult cattle. The disease progresses over a period of weeks to months until cattle are unable to stand up. Bulls with BPA going into cross-bred breeding programs should not cause any problems. Please discuss with the vendors the status of their sale animals. The following codes in this catalogue mean:

Free - BPA-F, Carrier - BPA-C, Not tested - BPA-NT.

UNDERSTANDING BREEDPLAN....

Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs)

Calving Ease EBV (%) are based on calving difficulty scores, birth weights and gestation length information. More positive EBVs are favourable and indicate easier calving.

- **CE% Dir = Direct Calving Ease** - The EBV for direct calving ease indicates the influence of the sire on calving ease in purebred females calving at two years of age.
- **CE% Daughters = Daughter's Calving Ease** - The EBV for daughters' calving ease indicates how easily that sire's daughters will calve at two years of age.

Gestation Length (days) is an estimate of the time from conception to the birth of the calf and is based on AI records. Lower (negative) GL EBVs indicate shorter gestation length and therefore easier calving and increased growth after birth.

Birth Weight EBV (kg) is based on the measured birth weight of progeny, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.

200 Day Growth EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to early ages.

400 Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.

600 Day Weight EBV (kg) is calculated from the weight of progeny taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for age of dam. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.

Mature Cow Weight EBV (kg) is based on the cow weight when the calf is weighed for weaning, adjusted to 5 years of age. This EBV is an estimate of the genetic difference in cow weight at 5 years of age and is an indicator of growth at later ages and potential feed maintenance requirements of the females in the breeding herd. Steer breeders wishing to grow animals out to a larger weight may also use the Mature Cow Weight EBV.

Milk EBV (kg) is an estimate of an animal's milking ability. For sires, this EBV indicates the effect of the daughter's milking ability, inherited from the sire, on the 200 day weights of her calves. For dams, it indicates her milking ability.

UNDERSTANDING BREEDPLAN....

Scrotal Size EBV (cm) is calculated from the circumference of the scrotum, measured in centimetres and adjusted to 400 days of age. This EBV is an estimate of the sire's genetic merit for scrotal size and is positively correlated to age of puberty in female progeny.

Carcase Weight EBV (kg) is based on abattoir carcass records and is an indicator of the genetic differences in carcass weight at the standard age of 650 days.

Eye Muscle Area EBV (sq cm) is calculated from measurements from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcass data, adjusted to a standard 300kg carcass. This EBV estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate better muscling on animals. Sires with relatively higher EMA EBVs are expected to produce better muscled and higher percentage yielding progeny at the same carcass weight than will sires with lower EMA EBVs.

Rib Fat and Rump Fat EBVs (mm) are calculated from measurements of subcutaneous fat depth at the 12/13th rib site and the P8 rump site (from live animal ultrasound scans and from abattoir carcasses) and are adjusted to a standard 300kg carcass. These EBVs are indicators of the genetic differences in fat distribution on a standard 300kg carcass. Sires with low, or negative fat EBVs are expected to produce leaner progeny at any particular carcass weight than will sires with higher EBVs.

Retail Beef Yield EBV (%) indicates genetic differences between animals for retail yield percentage in a standard 300kg carcass. Sires with larger EBVs are expected to produce progeny with higher yielding carcasses.

Intramuscular Fat EBV (%) is an estimate of the genetic difference in the percentage of intramuscular fat at the 12/13th rib site in a 300kg carcass. Depending on market targets, larger more positive values are generally more favourable.

Selection Indices

Northern Marernal Index (NMI): Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial self-replacing herd where Charolais bulls are joined with Bod indicus cows in Northern Australis targeting the grass fed Jap ox market. Selected heifers are retained for breeding and so maternal traits are of importance. Steers target 650kg live weight (360kg HSCW and 12mm p8 fat depth) and heifers 630kg (340kg HSCW and 14mm p8 fat depth), at 26 months of age. In response to industry feedback, positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

UNDERSTANDING BREEDPLAN....

Domestic Terminal Index (DTI): Estimates the genetic difference between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a typical commercial herd where Charolais bulls are joined with a British breed cow base (eg Angus) targeting the domestic trade. This index assumes all progeny will be marketed with steers finished in the feedlot for 90 days, and weighing 450kg (250kg HSCW and 7mm p8 fat depth) when marketed at 12 months. Heifers will be in the feedlot for 75 days, and weigh 430kg (230kg HSCW and 9mm p8 fat depth) at 12 months. In response to industry feedback, positive emphasis has been placed on finishing ability.

Accuracy

Accuracy (%) is based on the amount of performance information available on the animal and its close relatives - particularly the number of progeny analysed. Accuracy is also based on the heritability of the trait and the genetic correlations with other recorded traits. Hence accuracy indicates the 'confidence level' of the EBV. The higher the accuracy value the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBVs as more information is analysed for that animal or its relatives. Even though an EBV with a low accuracy may change in the future, it is still the best estimate of an animal's genetic merit for that trait. As more information becomes available, an EBV is just as likely to increase in value, as it is to decrease.

Accuracy values range from 0-99%. The following guide is given for interpreting accuracy:

- **less than 50%: Low accuracy.** EBVs are preliminary and could change substantially as more performance information becomes available.
- **50-74%: Medium accuracy.** Usually based on the animal's own records and pedigree.
- **75-90%: Medium-high accuracy.** Some progeny information included. EBVs may change with addition of more progeny data.
- **more than 90%: High accuracy** estimate of the animal's true breeding value.

As a rule, animals should be compared on EBVs regardless of accuracy. However, where two animals have similar EBVs, the one with higher accuracy could be the safer choice, assuming other factors are equal.

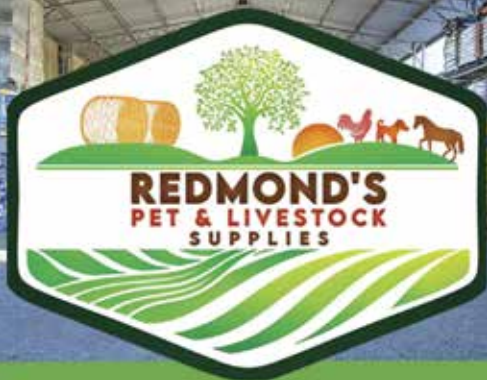

STANDARD STUDD STOCK-AUCTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE
